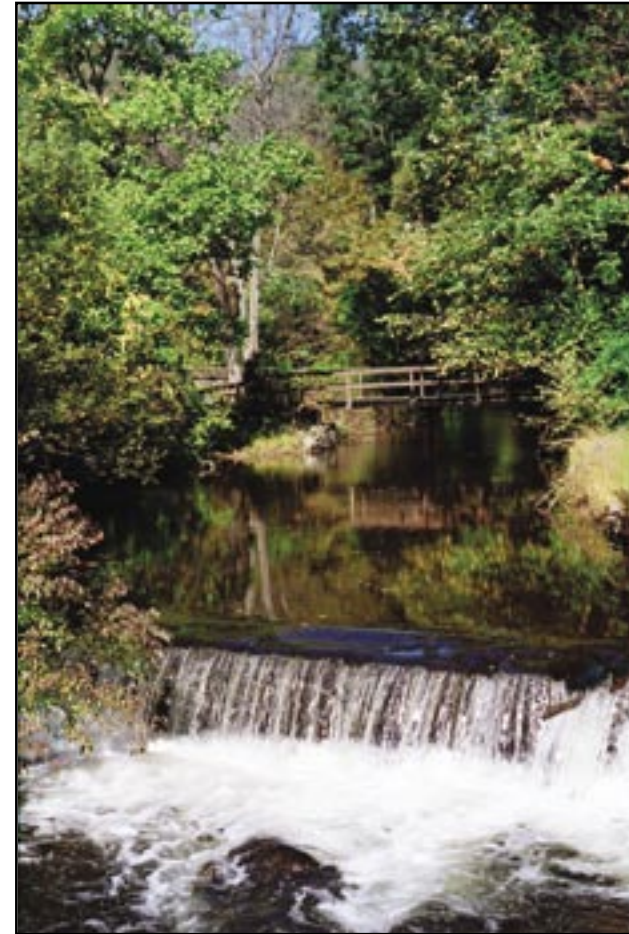


A recreational resource for people of all ages
